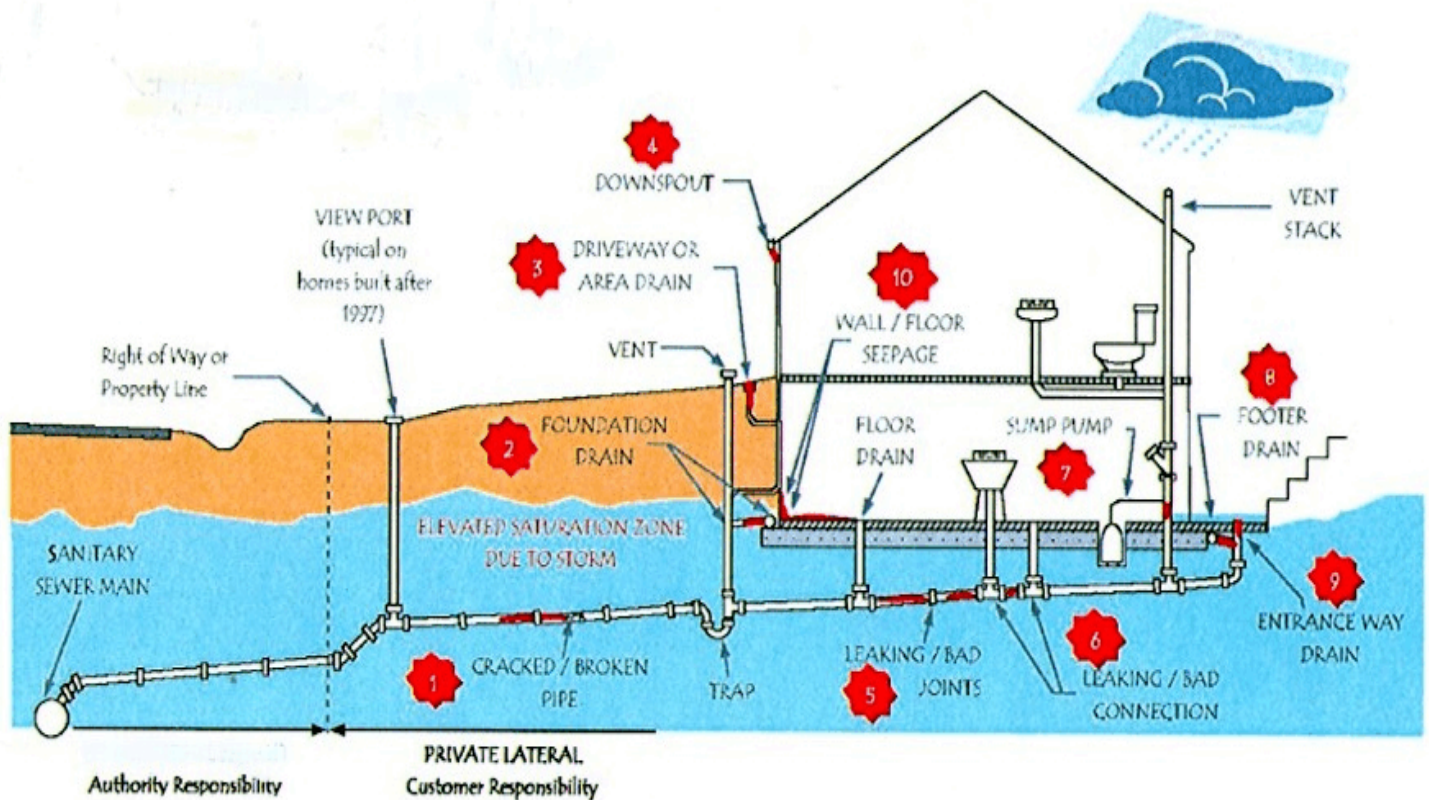


PROHIBITED DISCHARGE STANDARDS AND PENALTIES

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any storm water, surface water, spring water, ground water, subsurface drainage, building foundation drainage and/or basement drainage into the Publicly Owned Treatment Works (POTW) by any means including connecting a sump pump discharge pipe or outlet to pump or drain into the Upper Macungie Township sanitary sewer system.

Any person who discharges or causes to be discharged any water under the above conditions shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a summary offense, punishable of a fine of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per violation, per day, or in default thereof, by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.



THE SOURCES OF UNPERMITTED (ILLEGAL) DRAINAGE OF STORMWATER AND GROUNDWATER POSSIBLE AT YOUR HOME

NOTE: Ordinance 2008-3 requires a sewer inspection upon transfer of ownership. Section 5, paragraph (D) of this ordinance requires that the purchaser of the property is responsible for the inspection should it not be performed prior to sale. Should the property not be in compliance with the provisions of this ordinance, the property must be brought into compliance within forty-five (45) days of the date of inspection. All responsibilities associated with Ordinance 2008-3 are those of the buyer and/or seller and not of any agency representing either party involved in the sale of the property.
