F. Fire Police

There has been concern that Fire Police are remaining on scene long after the fire department has completed their work. It was discussed that a letter would be sent from the Township to PennDOT and the PA State Police that it's the Township's desire that Fire Police be released from a scene at the same time the Fire Department is released.

III. OLD BUSINESS

A. Action Item List Update

Mr. Christ reviewed the list of action items developed after the June 18, 2019 meeting:

- Equipment Lists - Secretary Sostarecz stated that the PA DCED offers many different studies to municipalities for fire services, one of which being a Fire Apparatus Study in which they analyze the apparatus at each station, service records, and ideally what type of apparatus should be at each location. The study is free, but there is a waiting list to take part in it. The initial action would be a letter of intent from the Board.

Motion by Supervisor Rader to authorize the Letter of Intent for a PA DCED Fire Apparatus Study to be submitted. Seconded by Chairman Brunell. The motion passed unanimously.

- Boiler Replacement – Budgeted for 2021
- Parking Lot Rehabilitation – Has been completed; however, the alleyway is still in need of resurfacing. Scott Faust will provide an estimate and the Fire Company will approach property owners on the other side of the alley to see if they are willing to pay for the portion that is on their property.
- Updated False Alarm Fees – The ordinance needs to be reviewed to determine if the fees are substantial enough to limit the number of false alarms. The fees should also be pulled out of the Code and put into the Fee Schedule which is updated annually.
- Fund Truck Headlight Upgrade – Completed
- Check on 501(c)(3) vs. 501(c)(4) – Bob did check with the non-profit attorney and there was no advantage in switching
- Copy of I-990 Tax Return - Completed


