# UPPER MACUNGIE TOWNSHIP PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD Monthly Meeting June 27, 2013

The monthly meeting for the Upper Macungie Township Recreation Board was held on June 27, 2013 at the Municipal Building. <u>Dog Park Completion/Status</u> – Dog letter donations have totaled \$1215 (an additional \$735 since the thermometer went up.)

Breinigsville Baseball Fields – Tabled

<u>Sponsorship Signs</u> – Friends Of Upper Macungie Township could raise money selling vinyl signs for the ballfield fences. The BVETS could also raise money with this program. A commemorative walk selling engraved pavers was another suggestion and more information will be obtained. Kathy will talk to Dean about the feasibility of a commemorative walkway at Grange Park. The pavers may be easier to sell/implement.

Amphitheatre – No updates on the splash park. Jim Adams to look into Amphitheatre.

<u>Independent Park Community Center</u> – 3 additional rentals last month. Several more residents wanted dates that were already booked. Jim Soltis will put a "Taking Reservations" sign at the facility for people to see. Linda suggested putting info in the Wedding Guide and the Parkland Press. Basement is spackled and painted and the roof will be fixed next.

<u>Program Instructors, usage, fees, payments</u> - A Contractor Contract will be prepared and reviewed by the township solicitor setting forth terms for instructors who want to use our parks/facilities for programs. The board decided on a 70/30 split with payments being released at the end of the program. All instructors will need to sign the form at the recreation board meeting and the supervisors will vote at the next board meeting to approve the program. Sean suggested we check liability & release forms. Kathy will check on this as our insurance is renewing shortly.

#### **New Business**

<u>Park Updates</u> – Grange playground completion has been delayed due to the rain. The swings will be installed when the surface is completed. The playground bathrooms will be going up for bid. Independent Park ground floor work will be on rainy days or in the winter.

A motion was made by Linda Gorr, seconded by Sean Gill to adjourn the meeting at 8:22pm. Next month's meeting is scheduled for July 25<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm at the Township Building.
