Bret motioned to table discussion on Sports Equipment Swap and Beerfest to allow for review of past discussion/minutes since it had not been discussed in a few meetings. Wes seconded; all were in favor.

- Ice rink- presented by Lynn as a piece of a larger winter event at Grange with decorated trees by organizations/sponsors, food trucks, the ice rink. There would be an admittance charge for the ice rink (poss. \$10). The Allentown Rotary is interested in being a Co-Host. Sponsors would be sought after.
  - The board suggested a snowmen contest from cardboard boxes, keeping the ice rink for a
    weekend or a full week, there was discussion on what it would entail to own a seasonal ice rink
    or fake ice rink
  - Pricing and funding research is needed
  - Bret mentioned having it as a stand alone weekend or week long offering due to the high cost and time to set up the rink.
  - Matthew and Jason Krier commented on current ice rink pricing (\$8 open skate)
  - Bret mentioned researching grants, and Friends soliciting sponsors and donations. Clarification is needed regarding Friends doing more of the fundraising
