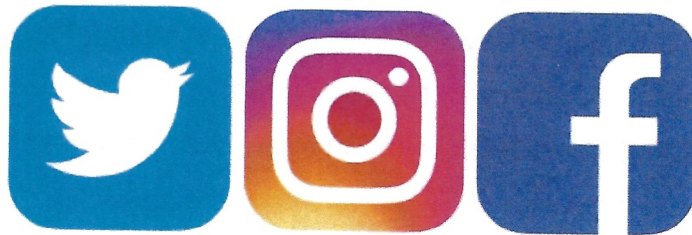
Monthly Highlights

UPPER MACUNGIE TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

February 2023

- On February 25th, the Upper Macungie Township Police Department, along with 13 other agencies, participated in the Lehigh County Police Testing Consortium examination for new police applicants. This test, which is typically held twice a year, allows participants the opportunity to take both a physical and written exam to become eligible to be hired as police officers with a Lehigh County police agency. This exam was held on the campus of DeSales University in Upper Saucon Township. As part of the physical exam, participants had to successfully complete a 1.5 mile run, 300 meter sprint, push-ups, sit-ups, and a vertical jump challenge. If the applicants pass both phases of the exam, they will then move on to the next phase of the process: an oral board evaluation.

2023 Spring/Summer Final Programs & Events Schedule

2023 Recreation Department General Update:

The department would like to welcome Kylene Gill to the UMT team. Kylene started her employment here as Recreation Supervisor on February 21, 2023 and comes to us with a wealth of knowledge in the field of parks and recreation. All recreation staff will be attending the Pennsylvania Recreation and Park Society (PRPS) in Hershey PA which takes place from March 19th-March 22nd.

Our current RecDesk income for 2023 (as of 2.16.23) is \$14,086.87. This is an increase of over 100% from the same time period last year which is attributed to the addition of new programs and increased marketing on social media. The department also received a successful grant award through the TreePennsylvania Bare Root Tree Program which will provide 20 larger trees (12'-15') to be planted in Grange Park. The department has created Annual Sponsorship Materials which will give us the ability to solicit donations for multiple events with one ask. The giving levels range from \$50 to \$2,500 which provides opportunities for individuals and corporations to support our programs at various levels. The hiring process for summer camp counselors has started as we look to double the number of counselors that we had in 2022.

Capital Projects:

10 Year Capital Improvement Plan

Staff continues to work on creating a 10-year capital improvement plan. This document will be incorporated into the upcoming Park, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan which we hope to accomplish in 2024.

Grange Park Wayfinding Signage

Staff is creating a wayfinding signage plan for Grange Park with the hopes of installing these signs in the spring/summer of 2023.

Marketing:

The department continues to work with all other department heads to finalize the Spring/Summer Township newsletter. Anticipated release date is April 1, 2023. In addition to other traditional marketing efforts, the department will be creating a e-newsletter which will be sent out to all RecDesk members at strategic times throughout the year.

Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR):

Department staff is completing two separate DCNR grant proposals. One to support the Russett Park improvements and one to support a Park, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan.
