- Geoff Creary and Anita Nardone of Simone Collins (SC) led the group through a presentation of the following agenda:
 - 1. From Trail Connectivity & Walkability Plan....to Vision Zero Action Plan
 - Why? Expanded opportunities for design and implementation funds!
 - 2. Summary of Analysis & Improvements Plan
 - Reviewing the process: Identified need, Public Input, 'Toolbox' of Improvement Concepts;
 site verification; analysis and design guidance documents; input from key stakeholders.
 - Additional analysis performed for Action Plan requirements of safety analysis, equity considerations, and policy/process changes.
 - Safety Data: Crash data shown graphically with heat maps.
 - o How do proposed improvements align with crash data? Add improvements as needed.
 - 3. What are 'Complete Streets?', What is 'Vision Zero'? Strategies that approach planning and design to enable safe access for ALL users (peds, bikes, motorists, transit users) with all abilities. And (Vision Zero) strategies that seek to eliminate traffic fatalities and severe injuries.
 - 4. Contents of the Report
 - Eight chapters
 - Final chapter containing the Priority Improvements Plan and the VZAP Matrix---a spreadsheet for tracking the progress of the measures recommended in the VZAP.
 - 5. Probable Cost Estimates
 - 'Corridors' = 'Areas' = TOTAL COST OF IMPROVEMENTS

 - Adoption of Completes Streets and Vision Zero policies for the Township

Discussion

- LANTA—Important Data on 'Equity'
 - One participant noted that the data available from LANTA on existing ridership and demands--along with LANTA planning for an UMT 'hub' is good information for the Township. LANTA is a
 good partner for this project.
 - SC noted that we have ridership data; and locations of proposed bus stops for future roue planning
 - Where is the 'hub' to be located? Nothing firm yet. A location that reduces the amount of transfers required to reach the warehouse destinations.
