# PLANNING REVIEWS COMPLETED FOR OCTOBER PC MEETING 2023:

**Docket #2358 – Schaefer Run West, Lot II, Revised Final Plan, Waterbury Court** – The applicant is proposing to revise the recorded Waterbury Court condo twin homes plan. The private roadway, serving eight (8) residential units within Lot II, was constructed not according to the recorded plan. The application reflects existing conditions and proposed improvements to meet the recorded plan. The project is located within the Township's R3 – Medium Low Density Residential Zoning District. This revised final plan was recommended for approval by the planning commission.

**Docket #2048A – Mosser Road Subdivision, Revised Final Plan, 1050 Mosser Road** – The applicant is proposing to revise the recorded plan to show changes in the design of the sanitary sewer system for the 10-unit single family development. The project is located within the Township's R-3, Medium Low Residential Zoning District. This revised final plan was recommended for approval by the planning commission.

**Docket #2374 – 110 PA Route 100 Manufacturing Building, Preliminary Land Development, 110 PA Route 100** – The applicant is proposing the construction of a 150,400 square foot manufacturing building and associated site improvements including parking and stormwater facilities. The project is located within the Township's LI – Light Industrial Zoning District. This plan was tabled by the applicant therefore no action was taken by the planning commission.

**Docket #2357 – XPO Logistics Expansion, Preliminary/Final Subdivision & Land Development, 7649 Penn Drive** – The plan proposes an expansion of the existing site with an additional 21,278 square foot building addition and parking lot expansion. The site is located within the Township's LI – Light Industrial Zoning District. This plan was tabled by the applicant therefore no action was taken by the planning commission.

# **Recreation Department Updates:**

#### 2023 Spring/Summer Programs & Events

- 2023 Barktoberfest 23 vendors and 3 food trucks. All in all, a successful event although attendance was a little lower than anticipated. The event took place on the rain date of October 15<sup>th</sup>.
- The new Trick or Treat Trail event on October 20<sup>th</sup> was a huge success. Roughly 2,500 to 3,000 people in attendance with 28 vendors and 2 food trucks.
- Noon Years Eve event planning Event on 12/31/2023 in Grange Park from 10:30am 1:30pm.
- In need of a new basketball coordinator to oversee the townships open adult basketball program in Veterans Elementary School on Monday nights from 7:00pm – 9:00pm.
- Yoga, Community Art classes, water aerobics, Chair Strength & Mobility classes, 3vs3 High school basketball league, adult basketball and volleyball have all started and have been well attended.

#### 2023 Recreation Department General Update:

- Emily Crosby-Piszczek was hired as the Recreation Supervisor and started on 10/16/23.
- Planting additional trees in Grange Park this Fall 20 from BareRoot Tree Grant to be planted in early November (exact date TBD), 30 purchased, and 51 donated through the Chesapeake Bay Foundation, Keystone 10 Million Trees Partnership, Owens & Minor, and the Lehigh County Conservation District planted on 10/28/23. Total number of trees to be planted in Grange Park in 2023 is 141 trees.
- Staff continues to work on creating a 10-year capital improvement plan. This document will be incorporated into the upcoming Park, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan which we hope to accomplish in 2024.
- Breinigsville Park Buffer will be planted in partnership with the Wildlands Conservancy in Spring of 2024.
