SR 222 AND SCHANTZ ROAD ROUNDABOUT:

Correspondence has been sent into PennDOT on 11/15/2023 requesting additional advanced signage be added along SR 222 warning drivers to not drive along side of truck within the roundabout. To date no response has been received from PennDOT.

SPEED LIMIT SIGNAGE:

UMT police department had several speed limit signage concerns along PennDOT State Highways Trexlertown Road (SR 6100), Hamilton Blvd (SR 6222), SR 222 Bypass, and Cetronia Road (SR 3008) A letter was sent into PennDOT requesting speed limit signage replacements due to small size or age of sign, informing of missing speed limit signage, consideration for lowering of the speed limit along Hamilton Blvd.

PLANNING REVIEWS COMPLETED FOR NOVEMBER PC MEETING 2023:

Docket #2349 – Fogelsville Elementary School Parking & Driveway Improvements – The applicant is proposed improvements to the exiting site which includes expanding the parking lot and modifying the driveway access to allow for better circulation for cars, buses, and emergency services. The property is located within the Townships LI -,Light Industrial Zoning District. This plan was recommended for preliminary approval by the planning commission.

Docket #2354 – Estates at Woodmere Preliminary Subdivision and Land Development – The applicant is proposing to construct 100 lot signal family residential development. Improvements would include roadway modifications, stormwater facilities etc. All lot will be served via on lot septic systems. The project is located within the Township's R-1,Rural Residential Zoning District. No action was taken by the planning commission.

Docket #2376 – ATAS Building Expansion, Preliminary/Final Land Development – The applicant is proposing expansion of the existing manufacturing facility with an additional 53,900 sqft addition. The project is located within the Township's LI – Light Industrial Zoning District. No action was taken by the planning commission.

Docket #2357 – XPO Logistics Expansion, Preliminary/Final Subdivision & Land Development, 7649 Penn Drive – The plan proposes an expansion of the existing site with an additional 21,278 square foot building addition and parking lot expansion. The site is located within the Township's LI – Light Industrial Zoning District. This plan was tabled by the applicant therefore no action was taken by the planning commission.

SR 222 AND GRANGE ROAD DUAL RIGHT TURN LANE:

This project has been completed and currently in operation.

Recreation Department Updates:

2023 Spring/Summer Programs & Events

- Staff continues to plan for the annual Kids Noon Years Eve event taking place on 12/31/2023 in Grange Park from 10:30am – 1:30pm.
- Fall programming: Yoga, Community Art classes, water aerobics, Chair Strength & Mobility classes, 3vs3 High school basketball league, adult basketball and volleyball were all well attended.
- New indoor programs (Mighty Kicks Soccer, Adult Zumba, Mad Science Camps, Lil Athletics) will begin soon and run through the winter months. Adult basketball and volleyball, Yoga and community art classes will also continue to be offered to the community through the winter months.

2023 Recreation Department General Update:.

- 2023 Grange Park tree plantings completed with 141 trees planted this year.
- Staff has been completing comparable research and will be recommending changes to the 2024 Parks and Recreation Fee Schedule.
- Staff received and installed the Message Center and Publication Racks which were purchased through the Lehigh Valley Greenways Grant.
- New trashcans and recycling bins have been installed throughout Grange Park.

Past Grants:

- DCED - GTRP to support Russett Park Improvements (\$85,271.52)
- DCED - the creation of an updated Park and Recreation Master Plan (\$85,000).
 - *The CFA Board Meeting scheduled for September 19th had to be postponed. All applications that were to be presented for approval at that meeting were now to be presented at the next CFA Board Meeting on November 21st. Due to time constraints, the program approvals which were rescheduled to be reviewed November 21st had to be delayed and will now be reviewed at their January meeting.*
- DCNR - to support Russett Park Improvements (\$50,000 ask) - DENIED
- DCNR - the creation of an updated Park and Recreation Master Plan (\$50,000 ask) - DENIED
- TreePennsylvania Spring grant for 20 trees in Grange Park – AWARDED
- TreePennsylvania Fall grant for 20 trees in Grange Park – AWARDED
- Chamber of Commerce Main Street program to match the Lehigh Valley Greenways grant – DENIED.
- The Kay Brook Green Hills Swim Club provided a letter of commitment of \$3,000 to support Russett Park.
- PHEAA State Work Study Program for reimbursement of qualifying staff costs during summer. - DENIED
- Lehigh Valley Greenways grant for \$10,000 to install a message center, publication racks and trees in Grange Park. – AWARDED
- Local Share Account (LSA) grant for \$250,000 to help offset the costs associated with constructing the future Community Center. – AWARDED
- Keystone Communities Additional Appropriation grant award for \$250,000 to help offset the costs associated with constructing the future Community Center. - AWARDED
- Lehigh County Tourism Development Grant with an ask of \$15,000 to help offset the costs associated with purchasing and installing an electronic message board in Grange Park.
- HUD Grant - processing the \$750,000 HUD grant received to help offset the costs associated with constructing the future Community Lifestyle Center. – AWARDED
- T-Mobile Hometown Grant Program - \$50,000 grant request to assist with Community Center - DENIED
