Why Plan?

Township park and recreation facilities are the most visible component of local government. Residents interact with Upper Macungie Township through parks and recreation more than any other township facility and program.

- Plan for current needs and future growth of Upper Macungie
 Township parks, open space, and recreation system
- The community facilities are essential green infrastructure that provides physical, spiritual & health benefits
- Makes your community competitive to attract businesses & residents
- Can be utilized as a planning tool to guide decision making for the Township for the next 10 to 20 years for improved facilities, non-motorized connectivity (trails), preserving open space, and enhancing recreational programming, maintenance, and staffing.





The growth of Upper Macungie...

Projected population growth of <u>18,000</u> between 2020 and <u>2050</u> (<u>67% growth</u>). Total Lehigh Valley growth is <u>100,000</u> overall (you are <u>18% of that growth!</u>)

14,000 new jobs in the Township between 2020 and 2050 (second only to Bethlehem)

- Where will these people enjoy and be restored by the natural worlds?
- Where will these workers recharge their batteries?


The Lehigh Valley Return on Environment Report (2014) takes on added significance in the context of this amazing growth in the Township and in the entire Lehigh Valley.



Open Space Definition

Open spaces are areas of land and water designated for use as active or passive recreation and/or for natural resource protection. Open space includes:

- Parks with both active and passive recreation
- Agricultural lands including wineries
- Natural lands such as wetlands, woodlands, etc.
- Untended lands
- Connecting greenways, blueways, and trails




 Limerick Township Comprehensive Open Space Plan (2021)

• In general, how well do you think the age groups listed below are served by the parks, recreation, and open space in Upper Macungie Township?

















